



3 SPEEDS SKILL

This is an exceptionally difficult putting drill, however it can be adapted to suit your level. To complete the drill you will need a ghost hole, 4 tees and a few balls.

To begin start with a simple 6 foot, flat or uphill putt. Place the ghost hole on the floor and mark your starting point using a tee. Then behind and slightly to the side of the hole the hole, place the 3 tees approximately 1ft, 2ft and 3ft behind the hole, these will become your speed zones.

The goal is to simply hit a putt that crosses the hole and finishes in each zone. For example putt one will be struck with the intention of crossing the hole and finishing somewhere within zone 1 (ie between the ghost hole and the tee placed at 1ft from the hole). The second ball should cross the hole and finish within zone two (between 1ft and 2ft past the hole) and then putt 3 should finish in zone 3.

Once you complete this you can change the putt. There are various ways to make this more difficult or less difficult. You can add distance, break and slope if you wish to make this more challenging. Or you can attempt to do all 3 in a row without missing.
