



## LONG & SHORT Performance

---

This putting game is designed to test your ability to 2 putt for par, and hole out when it really matters!

To begin you will place 9 tees randomly around a hole or holes, between 6ft and 12ft. These will be your “birdie putts”.

To begin you must select a random putt of 20ft or more. Consider this to be 2 putt territory however if you do one putt it stands as a birdie, 2 putts is a par, and 3 putts is a bogey etc. Once you have completed a long putt then move to one of your pre planned “birdie putts” between 6ft and 12ft. The scoring system still applies however for obvious reasons you should have a far higher chance of holing these putts. Once you have completed one of these short putts, pick up the tee and return to another random long putt (again 20ft or longer).

Repeat this process until you have attempted all of the short putts. Once completed add up your score relative to par.

All single putts are classed as birdie, all 2 putts par and all 3 putts birdie.
