



TOUR LADDER

Performance

The goal of this game is to be able to accurately attack flags and give yourself a reasonable chance of birdie with your iron play. You will need a launch monitor to complete this game, or alternatively you can attempt to do this on the course with a real flag.

You will begin the first “Rung” of the ladder at 100 yards. The task is to hit the golf ball within a 3% error in any direction . In other words between 97 yards and 103 yards for this rung.

If you do this successfully get the ball to finish within 3% of the target move up one rung to 110yards. Each rung will be 10 yards further than the previous distance.

If you finish within 10% of the target distance simply stay on the current rung and attempt another shot.

If you are outside of 10% then move down one rung (ie to 90 yards.

The goal is to try and get to 220 yards.

Your score will be the amount of shots that it takes you to complete 220 yards.

If you attempt this game and the dispersion percentages are too difficult you can adjust accordingly ie. change the dispersion to 5% instead of 3%
